

Kema NSF Product Range



THE FOOD SAFETY ACT 1990

Essentially, this states that harmful substances must not be added to food.

ITW Spraytec Nordic confirm that the entire Kema NSF range of products meets the requirements of The Food Safety Act 1990 in that the products are not formulated using ingredients which are regarded as injurious to health. Furthermore, the Kema range has been laboratory proven not to sustain bacterial growth.

In addition we can confirm that products in the Kema NSF product range:

- are manufactured only from F.D.A. listed ingredients
- are NSF H1 registered for incidental food contact
- do not contain any genetically modified ingredients
- do not contain nut oils or synthetic glycerides / esters derived from nut oils i.e. peanut, almond, hazelnut, walnut, cashew, pecan, brazil nut, pistachio, macadamia nut, or queensland nut
- do not contain any Jatropha oil or its derivatives
- do not contain Bisphenol, soya or lanolin
- do not contain sesame seeds, or extract derivative, or product thereof
- do not contain crustaceans, fish, eggs, mustard, celery... or products thereof
- do not contain animal fats or synthetic oils / derivatives refined from animal organs
- cannot transmit bovine or other spongiform encephalopathies (BSE / TSE). Ingredients and manufacturing process are free from BSE/TSE sources of contamination
- do not contain molluscs – all species e.g. oyster, squid, cockles, mussels, periwinkle & scallops including land molluscs like snails
- do not contain any dairy products or materials derived from dairy sources
- do not contain sulphur dioxide & sulphites at concentration above 10 mg/kg
- are milk, wheat and gluten free
- are formulated from biologically hard raw materials and do not sustain bacterial growth
- do not contain Lupin – (Lupin seed and Lupin flour and all species) and products thereof
- do not contain cereals containing gluten (i.e. wheat, rye, barley, oats, spelt, kamut, or their hybridised strains) and products thereof
- are not manufactured with any alcohol added to the formulation

There are no nut oil or nut oil derivatives used in the manufacture of our lubricants. Furthermore, to the best of our knowledge, we can confirm that no nut oil or nut oil derivatives are allowed in the manufacturing areas.
